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Get to know the ingredients in HerbaCoat[™]

Aloe Vera is typically used in natural remedies for humans and found in traditional medicine (India) for constipation, digestion and minor skin infections. In Traditional Chinese medicine, it's often used in the treatment of fungal diseases, and in the Western world, it has found widespread use in the cosmetic, pharmaceutical and natural health food industries. There are two parts of the plant used: aloe vera gel is the clear, jelly-like substance found in the inner part of the aloe plant leaf. Aloe vera latex comes from just under the plant's skin and is yellow in color. Aloe vera's active components have been identified in the plant includes: vitamins, minerals, saccharides, amino acids, anthraquinones, enzymes, lignin, saponins and salicylic acids. Aloe vera has a host of internal health uses for humans, however, the topical uses for aloe vera applied for skin conditions is equally interesting. Sunflower oil is used as a topical agent and surfactant in HerbaCoat[™].
